Policy Statement:

Lakemary Center, Inc. (LMC) will administer medication according to statutory requirements to ensure that all medications are administered as prescribed.

Policy:

LMC will comply with the Kansas State Board of Nursing and Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) regulations and guidelines to ensure appropriate care, storage, safe handling, administration, and disposal of medication. Compliance with these regulations and guidelines will be considered as part of the annual licensing inspections carried out by KDADS (Kansas Department on Aging and Disability Services), Psychiatric Rehabilitation Treatment Facility (PRTF) surveyors and Council on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) surveyors.

In the Adult Program, all persons and their families/guardians are responsible for communicating with staff or contractors regarding their desired support needs in relation to medication handling, storage, and administration. These supports will be outlined in the person-centered support plan (PCSP). Staff and contractors will deliver support as outlined in the PCSP.
