Policy Statement:

While respecting and promoting the rights of each person to make all choices for their lives, Lakemary Center maintains the responsibility to provide education and support, as directed by each person's person-centered support plan/treatment plan, including protecting them from individuals who would do them harm or release to unauthorized persons.

Policy:

Children's Services – Children supported will only be released to authorized personnel with a matching government issued ID.

Adult Services – Adults supported have the freedom to interact with whomever they choose, whenever they choose. These relationships are encouraged and supported as are all community and socially normative interactions. Lakemary documents these important relationships in each person's person-centered support plan, Additionally, if someone on the person's support team brings a concern to the team that one of these people may be having a detrimental effect or a harmful intention toward the person, the person and their team will meet to discuss the issue and document future plans for this relationship.
