#### **Spring Highlights**

As we move through spring, there's exciting progress underway at Lakemary. Here are a few updates about what's happening across our programs and plans for the future:

- Budget + Strategic Plan: We're finalizing our FY '25-'26 budget and launching a new three-year Strategic Plan. Staff across the organization are actively shaping both efforts.
- Wellness Program Launch: Staff are engaging in gym memberships, a walking challenge, and a 5K Run Walk.
- Johnson County Expansion: A new project committee is exploring a consolidated site in Johnson County to bring multiple programs under one roof. Early planning is underway.
- Advocacy: Jean Hoyt, Chief Program Officer, Children Services and I traveled to Washington the week of May 12 to meet with members of Congress and advocate for critical funding, including Medicare-related support. We had productive, face-to-face meetings with key decision makers to discuss the challenges facing organizations like Lakemary and the individuals we support.

The Explorers program & micro teams were created to support Lakemary's Strategic Plan. Teams were cross disciplined and tasked with creating growth opportunities for Lakemary Center. Business strategies were presented to Lakemary's Board of Directors and funding was approved for three programs.



## **MEANINGFUL Employment Matters**

Lakemary's creative enrichment program, **True Colors Collective**, provides meaningful employment opportunities for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities by empowering them to create original artwork. Participants transform their creativity into products such as notecards, prints, and stickers. These items are sold at Lakemary's Paola and Olathe campuses, as well as at local festivals and art shows. The program not only fosters artistic expression but also promotes inclusion and independence through purposeful work.

#### Turning aluminum cans into new possibilities!

Our aluminum can recycling program is a meaningful initiative that promotes sustainability while providing valuable skill-building opportunities for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. As part of their day service program, participants collect, sort, and prepare aluminum cans for recycling, contributing actively to their community. We are proud to partner with Topgolf, whose ongoing support enhances our mission and provides inclusive community engagement opportunities. This partnership demonstrates how collaboration can create lasting impact through environmental stewardship and social inclusion.



#### Lakemary's Employee Wellness

Employee wellness is a top priority, and we are committed to fostering a culture of health and well-being. Our program includes access to mental health therapy, personalized health coaching, and



discounted gym memberships to support physical and emotional wellness. Another key initiative is EQ2, a specialized training program designed to support our children's program staff who work with trauma-impacted youth by offering tools for social and emotional regulation. These efforts reflect our dedication to the well-being of both our employees and the communities they serve.
